Conditions of Entry

- These conditions are to be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf.
- Only Full playing members are eligible to enter this event.
- Rules of Fourball Matchplay apply.
- Each round must to be completed on or before the designated date.
- If both parties cannot agree on a date, the designated date shall be used as the default date; default time for tee off on this date shall be between 8:30am – 9:30am. Should both parties be unable to play prior to or on the designated date a decision may be reached by lot.
- Results of matches must be written on the draw by 7pm on the designated date. Any team not recording a result by this time will forfeit the next round.
- Maximum handicap for men is 27
- Maximum handicap for ladies is 45.
- The lowest marker reverts to scratch and gives strokes to the higher markers, eg A is on a 4 handicap, B is on 8, C is on 12, and D is on 27. A receives no strokes, B gets 4 strokes, C gets 8 strokes and D gets 23 strokes irrespective of who is A's partner.
- All play is to be from the markers of the day, Blue Tee Markers (Men), Red Markers (Ladies).
- No substitution of partners will be permitted after the scheduled date for the completion of the first round.
- Halved matches are decided by playing on from the first hole played, with strokes taken as appropriate until one side wins a hole. This arrangement includes finals.
- It is the player's responsibility to ascertain and apply his/her current handicap on the day of play.
- The committee reserves the right to cancel the event if there are fewer than 8 pairs entered.
- The committee is in control of the competition. In the event of a dispute the decision of the Committee will be final.
- The course and timing of the final will be at the sole discretion of the Committee.
- This is an Honour Board event. Presentations will be made at the club's annual presentation night dinner.
